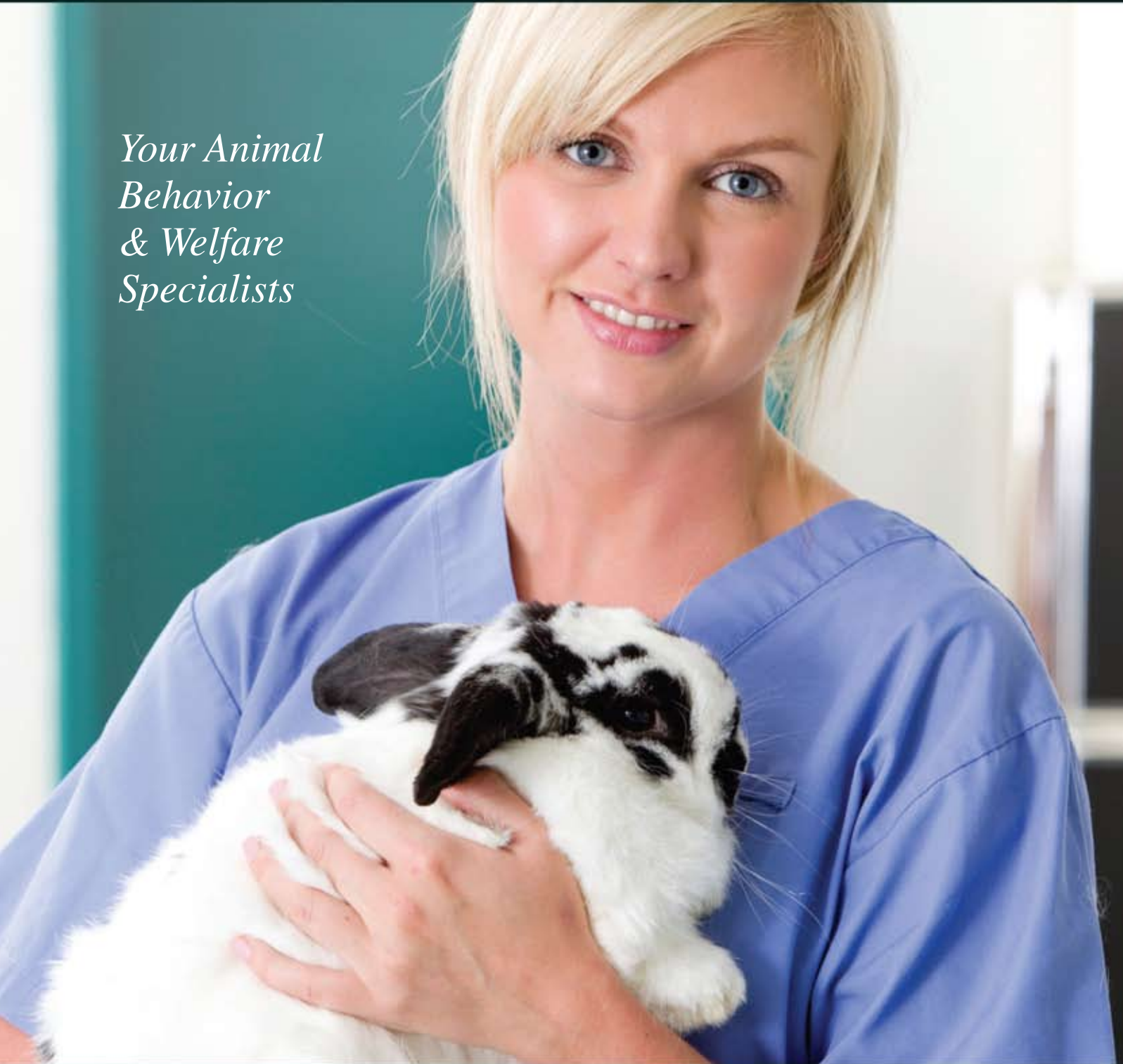

2. CONFIDENCE

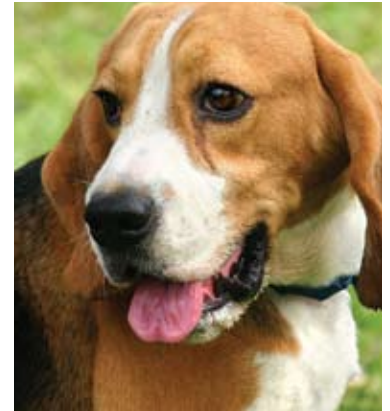

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT ARE YOUR COURSES LIKE?

Courses runs for 10 weeks; each week includes reading assignments, study guide activities, an interactive quiz and participation in the class discussion. Optional resources are also identified for students that would like to pursue selected topics further.

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO COMPLETE THE PROGRAM?
